I research vintage fashion for my blog on fashion history and I am always in need of books that cover the names of clothing, types of common garments, colors, materials, and especially men's and children's clothing. For this purpose I LOVE this book. It doesn't say much, mostly pictures of vintage 50's clothing (I agree with other reviewers they not up to today's photographic standards), but what little it does say is far more useful as a staring point into more

research then any other book on the 1950s that I have read. I enjoy seeing the real vintage clothing worn by men, women, and children that were not necessarily worn by movie stars or designed by big name designers. Real fashion history lies within the everyday clothing. I recommend this book for those who need to SEE what 1950s fashion was all about and as a place to begin more fashion research. It is not a written history of fashion like most other books on this topic cover which makes this book worth having in your collection too.
