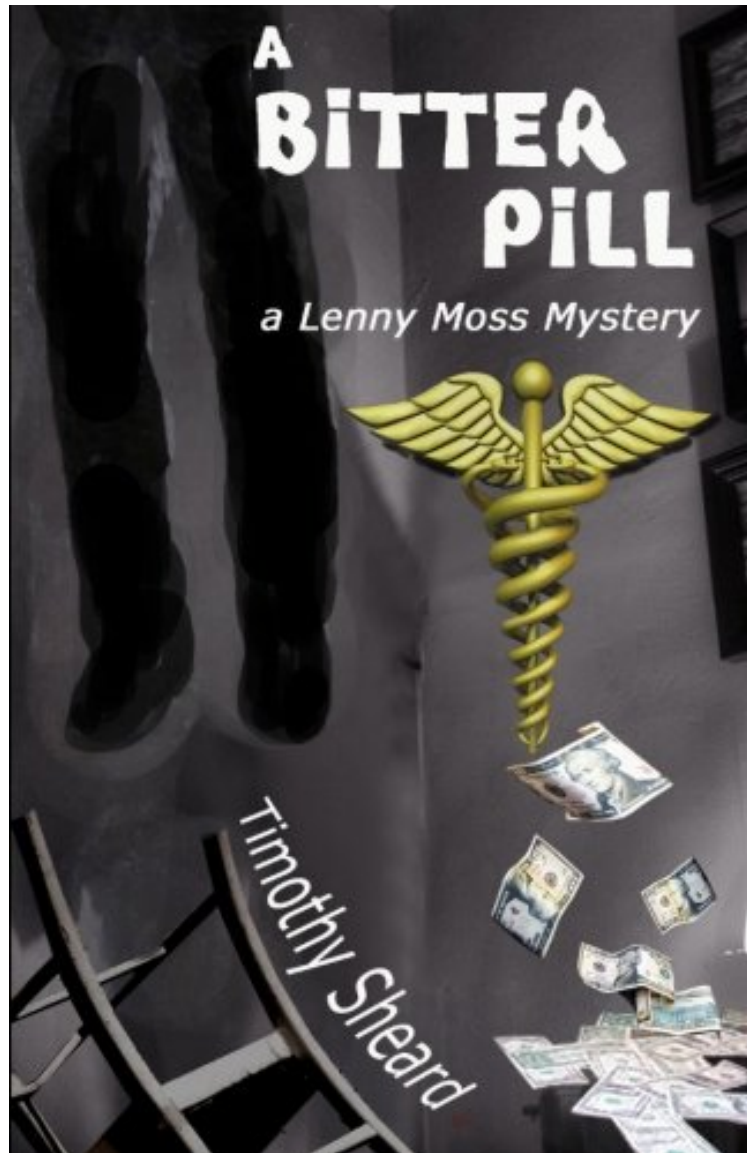

Lenny Moss and his friends at James Madison Hospital are in the fight of their lives. The new hospital president, Robert Third Reich Reichart, has turned the hospital into a for-profit facility and launched a campaign to decertify the union. If successful, the decertification drive will destroy the union and compromise patient care. Staffing levels will be slashed, and half the departments will be outsourced to private companies. In the midst of his struggle to save the union, Lenny learns that a troubled coworker has died under suspicious circumstances. Was it suicide or murder? With the bosses threatening to close the hospital if their slash burn policies are not accepted, and with the police pressuring him to help with the investigation, Lenny faces his most difficult case. This time, it's personal.
