

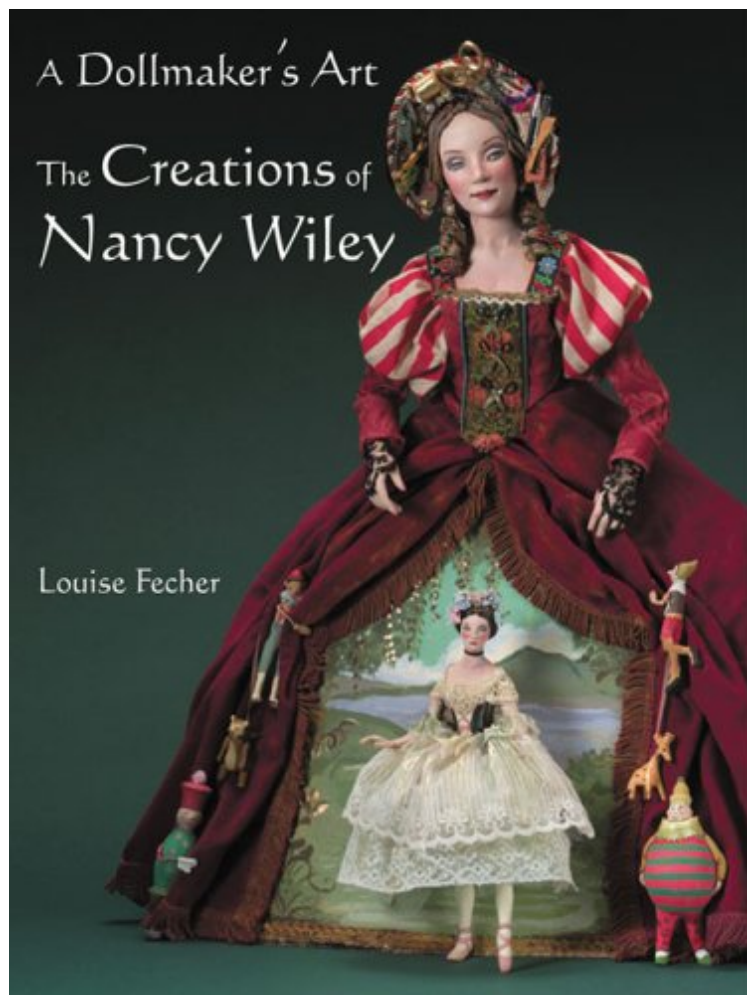

A Dollmaker's Art showcases 85 of Ms. Wiley's dolls in full-color photos, organized by theme and presented with insightful commentaries from the artist, and includes a step-by-step photo essay that demonstrates the development of one doll from start to finish.
