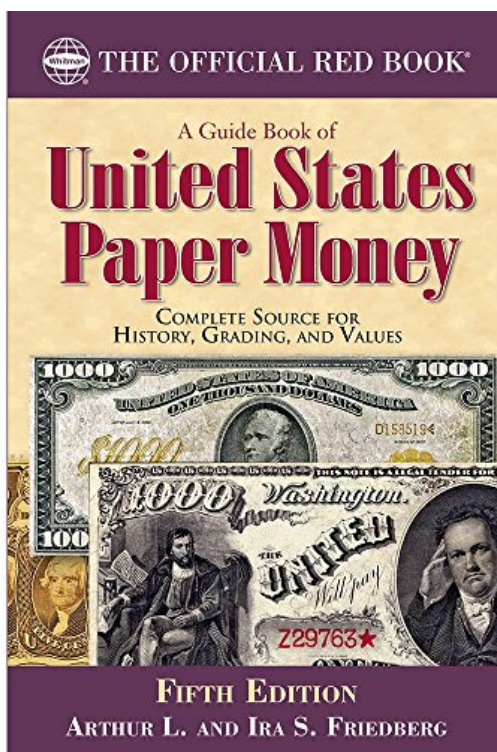

This version of the Red Book is easier to use for beginners because it is primarily organized by note value (\$1; \$2; \$5, etc.) rather than by note type so it is easier to find notes quickly in it.
