A pretty good book for it's age (1980), when the publication of photographic art books was problematic and expensive - hence the very few color photos. Even the B/W photos are not particularly crisp or well-defined, but at least there are a lot of them. It is good to see a book on African artisanship which doesn't feature the usual masks and figures. It is also good to see an effort to include a large number of "field" photos and illustrations which help put the objects in cultural and tribal context. The main sections cover : "House and Compound" (with layout illustrations), "Artisans", "Implements", "Furniture" (Including many chairs and stools), and "Containers". 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
