The work is an ideal complement and follow-up to Bambery's primer "Old Sheffield Plate." As the gold standard of volumes on Old Sheffield Plate, this volume presents the history of OSP, the history of the development of various mechanical processes (including innovations and improvements), and valuable sections with advice and recommendations for collectors. The sections on dating OSP and makers' marks are especially helpful. Chapters include a "Preface," "The Invention," "The Earliest Manufacturers of Sheffield Plate," "History of the Trade," "Processes, Practices and Inventors," "Surviving Methods, with Illustrations of Workshops, Tools, and Materials," "Innovations that Revolutionized the Old Trade," "Locality of Manufactur," "Advice to Collectors -- Designers," "On Ascertaining Dates of Specimens," "List of Makers and Their Marks," "Other Industries Connected with Old Sheffield Plate," "The Manufacture of Silver," and "The Britannia Metal Industry." The book not only details the genesis and development of the trade, but it also provides invaluable advice for both beginning and advanced collectors. Copious illustrations complement the text. The work concludes with a lengthy index to the text, as well as an index to marks.
