Not only are the current carousels detailed, but there are many lesser known carousels in this book, including lots of rare photographs. And, as a bonus, the book goes outside of Monroe County, New York and mentions carousels that operated in Roseland (Canandaigua, now in Syracuse), Long Point Park in Geneseo, and several others. It is thoroughly researched and a good read for both carousel lovers and local history buffs.

Many carousels that operated within Rochester, New York and beyond are long-gone. However, these carousels do not have to be forgotten. In addition to telling the stories of the current carousels, author Linda M. Bartash traces the history of former local carousels through different states, countries, and to their present whereabouts. The book represents an interesting and never-before released history of regional carousels, including many rare and lesser known

carousels. Besides Monroe County carousels there is also a mention of carousels outside the county, including Long Point Park (Geneseo), Roseland (Canadaigua), and others. The book has more than 65 photographs.

About the Author Linda M. Bartash worked for a local newspaper as editor for over 8 years. She has researched local carousels since 1994. *Horses in Motion* is the culmination of seven years of research on the whereabouts of Rochester's carousels.
