Simply designed to show the jewels at their best, with minimal type or explanation, little to no context, but page after page of wonder, owning this book is the epitome of any collection of books about jewels. JAR's superb design and craftsmanship exudes itself from the page. The richness of the base materials and precious gems is astounding. Even at \$2,500 this is a good buy.

Using exceptional precious and semi-precious stones mounted in rare and unusual metals, JAR jewels are classics with a twinkle. Galconda diamonds, Kashmir sapphires, natural pearls, Indian emeralds, Burma rubies as well as demantoid garnets, pink sapphires and spinels are regularly used in his creations. Rosenthal's demand for perfection in the

production of each piece is so high that only 60 to 70 jewels are made each year. All of them are unique - never duplicated. In this book you will discover 400 JAR creations, photographed using Rosenthal's personal vision via the photographer's special technique. For everyone even remotely interested in jewellery, this is a book you have to own.
