

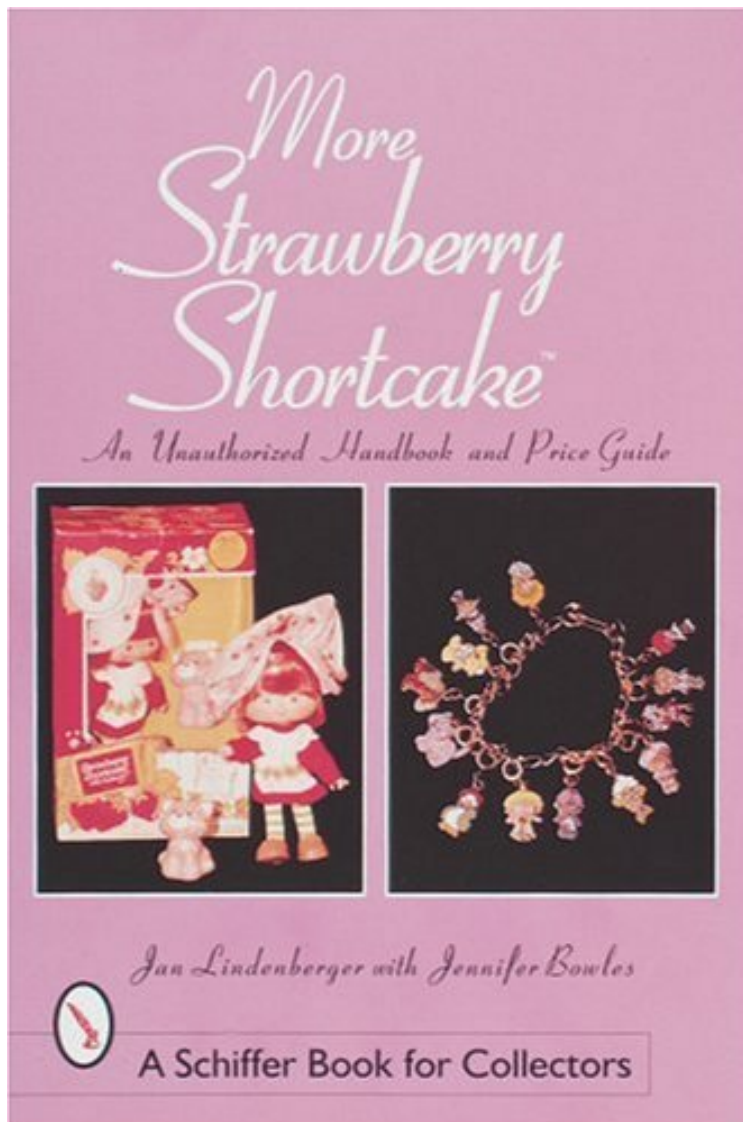

There is a lot of wasted area. For example, she has some pages with just 2 or 3 pictures of toys; inventory is still disorganized but an improvement from the original SSC Collector book.
