

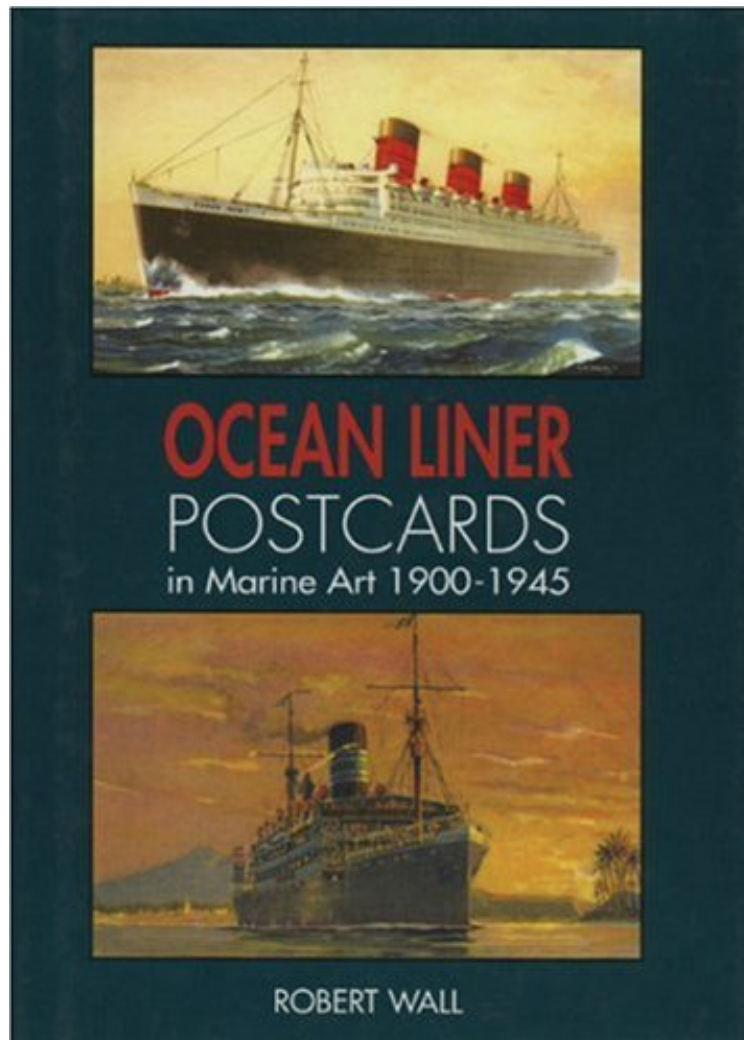

Two hundred artists' postcards from the author's comprehensive collection illustrate in full colour the ships plying the 'Blue Riband' routes and sailing to Canada, the

South Atlantic, India, the Indies. Australasia and the Far East. Famous names like Lusitania, Mauretania and Titanic are illustrated here alongside other less well-known vessels recalling bygone days of leisured and luxury travel, many of them lost in disasters or in the service of their countries in the two world wars.
